

GRADUATE CERTIFICATE *IN ACCOUNTING*



The Graduate Certificate in Accounting from the Kelley School of Business at IU Indianapolis provides the academic foundation to successfully pass the CPA exam, and it provides 12 credit hours of graduate education toward the 150 credit hours required to be licensed as a CPA in Indiana.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

12-credit hour program designed specifically for Kelley undergraduate students pursuing a degree in accounting.

Receive 6 graduate certificate credit hours at the undergraduate tuition rate by taking accounting electives in the Undergraduate Program.

When you pursue the graduate certificate, you can choose from a broader range of electives because you can take graduate-level courses that are open only to those enrolled in the certificate program.

Complete the remaining 6 graduate certificate credit hours at night during the summer after graduation, while studying for the uniform CPA exam (often in conjunction with a CPA review course). Financial aid is available.

If a master's degree is part of your plan, you can carry your graduate certificate credits into the MS in Accounting or MS in Taxation—leaving you with just 18 credit hours to complete one of these renowned Kelley degrees.
